Tent Capacity Planning Chart

You will notice on the Delux Tents website that tents are described by "widths". 20w equals 20' wide, 30w equals 30' wide and so on. Listed below are some of the common size tents and the seating capacity for each tent using both banquet and round tables. This guide assumes the tent will be used strictly for seating. As you add items under the tent, such as food tables, dance floors, etc., you will obviously lose seating. Use this guide to get you started. If you have questions, please call. One of our staff will be happy to assist you.

Generally speaking, 20' wide tents are ideal for backyard gatherings. Up to 100 people can be seated under 20' wide tents using banquet tables. 30' wide tents are used to seat up to 200 people. 40' wide, 60' wide and 80' wide tents are typically used to seat over 200 people.
